PSA RE: Fallen overhead lines

In light of the accident on the Priority Bus Route on August 2nd where a truck pulled down several utility poles and overhead lines, T&TEC offers the following guidance to the public on safety precautions to take in such circumstances.

Thankfully, most of the damage on Wednesday was to non-T&TEC equipment and therefore did not pose a shock or electrocution hazard to members of the public. However, unless trained, members of the public may not be able to differentiate between a T&TEC, Satellite TV or Telephone cable and can endanger themselves and others. It is therefore important to adopt extreme caution in such circumstances.
