Notice to conserve electricity

Public Service Announcement

T&TEC's customers in Tobago are being asked to conserve electricity in the coming days as the Commission conducts major maintenance work on a generator at the Cove Power Station. The work will run from Friday May 5th to Monday May 8th at 8 p.m.

While the work is being carried out the island will be served by the other machines at Cove as well as the undersea cable from Trinidad. As a precaution against excessive load demand on the system, the Commission is appealing to customers to conserve on the use of electricity by minimising the use of non-essential appliances and equipment to reduce the risk of load shedding.

The maintenance of generation is necessary to improve the reliability of the electricity supply to Tobago. T&TEC apologises for any inconvenience that may be caused to customers during this period.

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
