Distribution South - Sale No. 04-26: Thursday 16th April, 2026 at 2:00 P.M. at Point Fortin Depot (Southern Main Road, Point Fortin).

NB: Bids for Sale No. 03-26 and 04-26 would NOT be accepted if the MANDATORY Site Visits are not attended.

NOTE: All Tenderers are reminded that they must be equipped with their PPE, this includes steel toe safety boots and reflective vest for the above site visits. Sleeveless T-shirts and Short Pants are NOT permitted. No Tenderer will be allowed on site, unless properly outfitted.

CONDITIONS OF SALE:

1. ALL bidders shall submit a VALID "Old Metal and Marine stores dealer's licence". (Please note the sale of vehicles would not require such licence)
2. Sale submissions MUST be placed in the Tender Box provided in the lobby of the Procurement and Supplies Department, LP #846 Southern Main Road, King Village, California, Trinidad and Tobago. This can be done on any working day of the week (Monday - Friday) between the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 11:45 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. but not later than 1:30 p.m. on the closing date.
3. ON THE CLOSING DATE OF THE SALE, BIDS MUST BE DELIVERED NO LATER THAN THE ADVERTISED CLOSING TIME FOR THE SPECIFIC SALE.
4. Each bid must be SEPARATELY enclosed in a PROPERLY LABELLED SEALED ENVELOPE with the SALE NUMBER CLEARLY MARKED ON THE FACE.
5. All bids should be VAT Exclusive, however, VAT shall be applied to the award.
6. The Commission does not bind itself to accept the highest or any offer.

7. It is the Commission's practice not to enter into negotiations after awards have been made.
8. Tenderers are required to make a refundable deposit of ten percent (10%) of their bid price at the time of tendering by way of a certified cheque. Cheques will be returned to the unsuccessful tenderers. Winning tenderers who cancel their bids will not be refunded their deposits.
9. Tenderers are required to visit the locations and view the items. Bids tendered are final and the items are sold on an "as is", "where is" basis. (Refer to contact above for viewing).
10. Prospective tenderers may be asked to submit a plan for disposal of the item, or may have to undergo a safety audit before the sale is awarded.
11. THE SUCCESSFUL TENDERER WILL BE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE THE TRANSACTION WITHIN SEVEN (7) WORKING DAYS OF BEING AWARDED THE SALE. ALL ITEMS ARE TO BE REMOVED AT AN AGREED TIME FRAME WITH THE COMMISSION. IN THE CASE OF TRANSFORMERS, ANY SPILLAGE OF TRANSFORMER OIL WHILE REMOVING WILL HAVE TO BE MOPPED UP WITH THE APPLICATION OF AN ADEQUATE ABSORBENT PILLOW PROVIDED BY THE AWARDEE. IN THE CASE OF VEHICLES, THE LEGAL TRANSFER OF THE VEHICLE MUST BE EXECUTED PRIOR TO HAND OVER BY THE COMMISSION.
12. The Tenderer must ensure that all their personnel are equipped with the appropriate PPE upon arriving at the site to remove the item. An onsite safety orientation may be administered prior to removing the item.
13. On removal of the item, the contractor must ensure that the area is left in a clean and safe manner with all debris being removed.
